Juried Show - Space

Space is very limited. Spaces are pre-assigned and the Del Mar Village Association reserves the right to select participating vendors. The spaces measure 10' x 10'. Each vendor may reserve a maximum of two spaces. Layout may not extend beyond the boundary of assigned space. Tents must be provided by the vendor and must be self-supporting; tent pegs or stakes NOT permitted. No stakes or poles may be driven into a paved surface. The festival will not have a rain date. Vendors are encouraged to have suitable material to protect their work.

Each vendor must provide own tent, tables, chairs, etc. Tables must be skirted to the ground on all exposed sides. Please keep your display area neat. We strive to project a professional image.

Vendors must display for duration of festival hours and booth must be manned continuously. Vendors may not move from their pre-assigned space. No vendor may swap or resell a space to another vendor. Only one vendor per space, although a team producing the same product may share in a booth space as a single vendor. Spaces may be shared by two vendors producing separate products; however, each vendor must pay the application and space fees regardless of space sharing. The Del Mar Village Association is not liable for loss or damage to persons or property.

Outdoor Gift Vendor Application

Set-up is 8:00 am – 10:00 am. No disassembling before 4:00 p.m. Show Hours are Noon to 4:00 p.m. Sales Tax is the responsibility of the vendor. Space is 10' x 10' primitive – no overhead coverage. No electrical or water will be provided.
